Opportunity

Eligibility to apply for Hub-funded programs and **lead** projects (e.g. \$2.5m Innovation Program, \$1m Transformational Program)

Eligibility to become a **partner** in Hub-funded projects (e.g. \$2.5m Innovation Program, \$1m Transformational Program)

Assistance from SW WA Hub team during Future Drought Fund and climate-related grant rounds (e.g., project brokering, finding collaborators, grant application guidance)
